

Incident Notification

- Incident Date:** July 26, 2018
- Title:** **SABRE Mine Water Discharge**
- Description:** While a *hydrovac* truck was removing water from the North SABRE Clarification pond, the operator noticed that mine water was leaking onto the ground from the rear door seal. The operator immediately shut down the truck. Approximately 2m³ of mine water had been released to the environment. The water travelled down the outside berm of the north pond and collected in the laydown area adjacent the pond.
- Resolution:** Initial investigation revealed that the box liner in the truck had become detached and prevented the rear door from sealing adequately. A sample of the pond water was collected for chemical analysis. The mine water was removed from the affected area with a vacuum truck and taken to the Sue pre-sedimentation ponds for disposal. Further clean-up may be required, pending the results of the chemical analysis of the mine water. An investigation has been initiated.
- Effect:** The effects on the environment will be negligible. There are no effects on worker/public health or safety.
