Title: Moffatt Lake Exploration Camp Legacy Diesel Discovery

Description: As a result of preventative and corrective actions from a prior discovery of

diesel contaminated soil at the Moffatt Lake Exploration Camp in 2016, other areas in the vicinity of the camp were recently (2017) identified. The legacy areas were investigated and five of them were found to have hydrocarbon contamination and are being reported as a discovery as per Section 1-3 of the Discharge and Discovery Reporting Chapter of the Environmental Code. In all cases, the contaminated areas coincide with locations where diesel fuel tanks for building heaters were located. The cause of the contaminated ground is suspected to be from overfilling the diesel tanks and/or leakage from the tanks or lines over many years of

usage.

Resolution: The affected ground is being excavated and will be taken to the

hydrocarbon land-farm located at the nearby McClean Lake site for remediation. Confirmatory soil samples will be collected post remediation

activities.

Effect: The effects on the environment will be negligible. There are no effects on

worker/public health or safety.
